

Captain Helder Fialho de Jesus is a researcher and professor in the Military University Institute, out of active duty. He was the chief of the Cyber Defence Centre (CCD) of the Portuguese Armed Forces for 3 years (2017-2020). He is also a PhD candidate at NOVA University Lisbon on International Relations – Strategy and Security Studies.



Upon completing his studies in the Naval Academy he served in several officer's positions in the Portuguese Navy. The last one was as Director of the Navy Crypto, Data and Communications Centre, being the PRT Navy Rep in the NATO C3 Concepts and Requirements (Maritime) Capability Team (MC3Cat).

From 2009 to 2012 he was appointed to NATO, at SHAPE, Belgium, as CIS planner for exercises and operations. He was the National lead of the Portuguese team in NATO CWIX exercise (2018-2019) – the major interoperability exercise and the first National Rep @NATO Cooperative Cyberdefence Centre Of Excellence (CCDCOE) Steering Committee (2018-2020).

He is expert in Communications and Electronics Warfare; graduated in Information Systems (INESC), with the National Defence Auditor course (IDN), the Program on Cyber Security Studies (G.Marshall Center - Garmish) and the Strategic Leadership in the Global Societal Security Programme (Swedish Defence University).

He has participated in some seminars and conferences as a speaker, with the last being C-Days 2023 in Porto. He also collaborates with various entities, namely IUM, IDN, ISCS, FCSH-NOVA, UAL, and CIIWA, providing lectures on topics such as Cyberspace and Hybrid Threats.
