“O Instituto da Defesa Nacional vai organizar, entre 09 e 27 de setembro de 2024, a 25ª Edição do Curso de Defesa para Jovens (CDJ) que terá lugar, em simultâneo, nas suas instalações em Lisboa e no Porto, em regime de tempo parcial diurno.

Inicia-se em outubro o curso avançado de Economia de Defesa, fruto da cooperação entre o ISEG Executive Education e o Centro de Estudos EuroDefense-Portugal, tendo como objetivo ajudar as empresas nacionais a ganharem escala e consequentemente a internacionalizarem a sua internacionalização.

Este será o primeiro curso criado de raiz e desenhado à medida dos desafios reais e atuais associados à Economia de Defesa Europeia e Nacional, visando a consciencialização de que este é um Ecossistema em que o Investimento é produtivo, logo a dinamização desta política pública apresenta-se crítica para que se cumpram os compromissos internacionais que Portugal tem no âmbito da União Europeia e da NATO.

THE FUTURE IN DEFENSE

The challenges that the European Union nowadays faces, especially regarding the Security and Defence domain, manifest the deepening complexity of our International System or Order.

Addressing the complexities of security and defense requires a sustained, generational commitment to strategic solutions. It's crucial to recognize that the absence of threats is often unnoticed, yet their presence is acutely felt. Investment in defense should prioritize enhancing a society's understanding of its security status and identifying the most significant threats to its well-being. While countries facing immediate territorial threats have a tangible sense of danger,

nations like the US or Portugal must grapple with more nuanced, sometimes theoretical threats. This can lead to a lack of understanding and potential missteps in maintaining national security. To effectively tackle defense challenges, societal awareness and discourse are essential. Defense extends beyond the military, encompassing the entire populace who reap its benefits. The role of youth is particularly crucial, as they are acknowledged as agents of change in peace and security, exemplified by the United Nations Security Council Resolution 2250, which celebrates youth's pivotal contributions to conflict prevention and peacebuilding.

I would, however, add to that resolution, that it is not about being young, in age, but it is about being able to adapt to the fast evolution of our world, to the fast evolution of the subsequent challenges that we face. And in this way, young people are not the ones under 30 years, but the ones that want to build a safe and prosperous world for himself and for future generations.

While we learn, we have to impart basic knowledge, skills, and pro-defense attitudes to the youngest. The goal is to foster a pro-defense awareness that can adapt to various challenges, such as those posed by the Covid-19 pandemic, wars, global water politics, etc... Overall, this is about harnessing everyone's energy, creativity, and unique perspectives to contribute to a more peaceful and secure future.
